What kind of proposals can be sent?

Three types of submission formats will be considered:

1. Roundtable Sessions:

Composed of two presenters, each session will be 60 (sixty) minutes. Presenters will be allotted 10 (ten) minutes each to present their papers; 40 (forty) minutes will be reserved for discussion with the audience.

2. Workshops:

Each workshop will engage participants in experiences of thinking. Workshops will last two hours, consisting of two separate one hour thinking experiences.

3. Contributed Papers:

Only papers that have an explicit link with the themes of the Colloquium will be accepted. Sessions will be organized so that each presenter will be allotted ten minutes to present their paper and twenty minutes for discussion with the audience.

When?

From February 1st to April 5th of 2016.

How?

Submissions will require complete works and must be uploaded through this site

Step by step:

1. Register with login and password (if do not have, fill the form);
2. Enter Title (Título), abstract (resumo) and three key-words (palavras-chave);
3. Upload your PDF file (no bigger than 4Mb) with the complete work;
4. Each autor can present just one paper with no more than 2 coauthors;
5. Each contributed paper (whether alone or in a round-table) should have between 25.000 and 45.000 characters with space. Title: bold, centered; name of autor(s), institution and email justified to the right. Proposals for workshos: same characteristics but between 15.000 and 25.000 words.

The proposals will be evaluated based on the criteria bellow:

- Relevance/ appeal for the fields of Philosophy and Education;
- Rich and consistent conceptual development in the formulation of problems;
- Clarity/ coherence in the presentation of theme or argument as well as methodological adequacy;
- Interchange of ideas with academic production in aforementioned fields;
- Originality and interesting contributions to the fields of Philosophy and Education.
